RE: By-Election Update

As Council is aware, Eric Stewart resigned as Councillor for the Town of Borden-Carleton effective April 30, 2024, and Council set Oct 28, 2024, as a date for a By-Election for one (1) Councillor and nominations closed on Friday Oct 11, 2024.

On Thursday Oct 17, 2024, Laurel Palmer submitted her resignation due to personal reasons as Councillor for the Town, meaning that there are now two (2) vacant seats on Town Council.

For the By-Election scheduled for Oct 28th, two nominations were filed on Oct 11th. Subsequently, both candidates withdrew their nomination on Oct 17th, 2024, <u>meaning there are no nominated candidates for the By-Election scheduled for Oct 28, 2024.</u>

This means, Council may readvertise a By-Election and it can be for filling two (2) Councillor vacancies on Town Council.

If we started over, because of the required notice by the Guardian/Pioneer/Journal the earliest an ad can appear is Oct 31st, <u>Therefore, the earliest a By-Election could be held would be on Monday December 2nd, 2024.</u>

Council would need to meet at a special meeting and consider passing the following Motions.

Whereas Eric Stewart resigned as a Councillor for the Town of Borden-Carleton on April 30, 2024; and Whereas Council has advertised a By-election for Oct 28, 2024, to replace one (1) vacancy on Town Council; and Whereas two nominations were received on Oct 11, 2024, and both nominations subsequently withdrawn on Oct 17, 2024, for Councillor for the Oct 28th By-Election, meaning that there are no candidates for the Oct 28, 2024 By-Election and therefore a new By-Election would have to be set; and

Whereas Laurel Palmer resigned as a Councillor for the Town of Borden-Carleton on October 17, 2024, creating a second vacancy on Town Council.

Therefore, Council hereby cancels the By-Election for one (1) Councillor slated for October 28, 2024, and sets Monday December 2, 2024, as the date for a By-Election to fill two (2) Councillor vacancies on Town Council.
